Stefano Farina Gavi 2016, Gavi di Gavi DOCG, Italy

A fruity and floral fragrance combines with hints of minerals and dried fruits. Pleasant, well balanced notes of almond blossom give this wine all of its rich personality to pair with a variety of dishes, or simply to enjoy as an aperitif.

Lagaria Chardonnay 2013, Vigneti Delle Dolomiti, Italy

Highly influenced by the cool northeastern mountain climate of the Dolomites, Lagaria offers complex yet lively aromas of fresh apples, pear and tropical fruit. Elegant undertones of vanilla and spice are present from partial ageing in French oak barrels, while a crisp mineral quality is inherited from further ageing in stainless steel.

Corte alla Flora “Podere Del Giuggiolo” 2014, Tuscany

This estate, due east of the town Montepulciano, was established in the early 1990's. Corte alla Flora is one of the top ten producers with 100 acres of vineyards. 100% Sangiovese Grosso, a high-quality clone, indigenous to the region, ages well. This intense ruby red wine is soft, nicely balanced with a velvety texture and enjoyable freshness.

Donna Laura “Ali” 2015 Toscana

90% Sangiovese, 10% Cabernet Sauvignon blend gives juicy aromas of red berries. A silky medium-bodied wine with balanced acidity and ripe tannins. Soft on the palate with hints of earth, tobacco spice, leather and red cherry on the finish. “Ali,” wings in Italian, is the name of the owner's daughter.

Dainero Toscana 2012, Riparbella, Italy

90% Merlot, 10% Sangiovese aged 6 months in French oak barriques. Grown along the coastline where Tuscany meets the Mediterranean Sea, Dainero is a finely-balanced wine, showing intense notes of ruby red fruits and spices. Full-bodied, the combination of the powerful Merlot and Sangiovese meet the freshness of the coastal vineyard.

Prunotto Pian Romulado 2012, Barbera d'Alba

A superb Barbera for an excellent value! 12 months ageing in oak casks followed by 4 months in bottle. An unquestionably balanced wine with hearty notes of blackberries and spices. Full and harmonic. Prunotto is owned by the famous Marchesi Antinori family.
