#### **Patz & Hall Chardonnay 2015, Sonoma Coast**

**Reg. \$36.99 SALE! \$29.99**

Complex aromas of pineapple and guava are complimented by notes of spiced almond and lime zest. Luscious and mouth-filling with a decadent appeal perfect for a variety of dishes and occasions. This artisan producer of small-lot Chardonnay has garnered **+91 Points Wine Advocate; +91 Points Wine Enthusiast**.

#### **Luli Rosé 2016, Central Coast**

Luli represents a partnership between Master Sommelier Sara Floyd and the Pisoni Family of winemakers. 50% Grenache, 50% Pinot Noir blend. The Pinot Noir grapes undergo fermentation in neutral oak barrels, adding subtle textural elements, while the Grenache, vinified in stainless steel, preserves the fresh fruit qualities.

#### **Masút Estate Vineyard Pinot Noir 2014, Eagle Peak, Mendocino Co.**

Proprietors Ben & Jake Fetzer are grandsons of the legendary Barney Fetzer, a Mendocino wine pioneer. Their well-grown Pinot Noir is aged in French oak barrels, followed by 15 months sur lie. Intense high-toned red fruits combine with hints of licorice and baking spice. Racy acidity and youthful tannins contribute to its well-rounded structure. Masút is a local Native American word meaning “dark, rich earth.”

#### **Daou Vineyards Cabernet Sauvignon 2016, Paso Robles**

The Daou brothers are well known for their rich, lavish high-end wines, however this Cabernet Sauvignon provides a taste of that opulence at a reasonable price! Robust and fruit forward, this full-bodied wine offers notes of blackberry cassis and plum while powerful acidity and fine tannins work harmoniously together. **+93 Points Wine Enthusiast**

#### **Cosentino Winery “The Zin” 2015, Lodi**

Consentino Winery is credited with creating the first designated and licensed Meritage wine, Bordeaux inspired blend in the late 1980’s that set the standard for other Napa Valley wineries to follow. A rich blend of 76% Zinfandel, and trace amounts of Cabernet Franc, Petite Sirah, Cabernet Sauvignon and Carignane. Sharp notes of raspberry, clove and cranberry meld into lovely tannins and a soft acidity.
